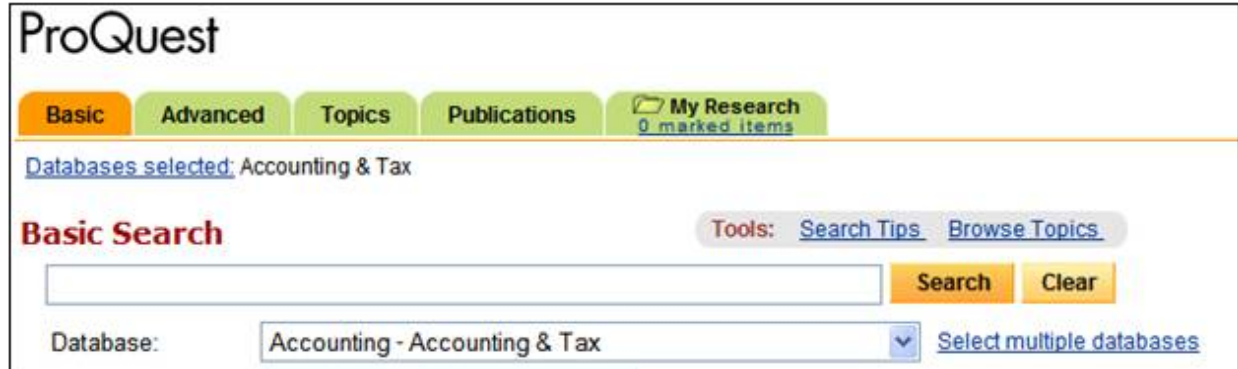


Several new databases have been added to our array of resources since last semester.

History Resource Center: World is a comprehensive collection of award-winning reference titles, full-text articles from leading scholarly publications, an array of primary sources, and images, maps and charts that provide expansive geographic and chronologic research materials for the study of world history. From ancient Europe to Latin America and from the Far East to the Renaissance, world history curricula is supported with over 1,800 primary sources, 40 reference titles and more than 150 periodicals.



Research Starters - Sociology provides students with guidance for their research and assignments, as well as overview information on topics relevant to their studies. Comprehensive summaries of discipline-specific topics are designed to help students grasp the broad outlines of a subject, realize its real world applications, critically engage it, and locate sources for advanced research. Articles average 3,000 words, providing concise yet more in-depth content than many textbook or encyclopedia entries.



Access World News: Research Collection provides the full text of 4,261 local, in-state, national and international news sources, including newspapers, news magazines, broadcast transcripts, newswires, news blogs, news web-only content, and video. Email *Alerts* and "my personal" functionality help users track and manage their projects as they research the unique current and archived news content for information on topics, events, issues, people, and businesses through this in-depth resource.



Literature Resources from Gale allows simultaneous searching of several Gale Literary databases for articles by or about an Author, the Name of the Work, Keywords, etc. You can search in *All Electronic Resources*, *LitFinder*, or *Literature Resource Center* and you can limit your search by publication date or century. This database covers *Literature criticism*, *Biographies*, *Topic and Work overviews*, *Reviews and News*, *Primary Sources* and *Full text of many literary works* - all searchable at the same time and returned in lists organized according to the type of research needs they serve.
